The total has almost doubled from \$777 million in 2011.

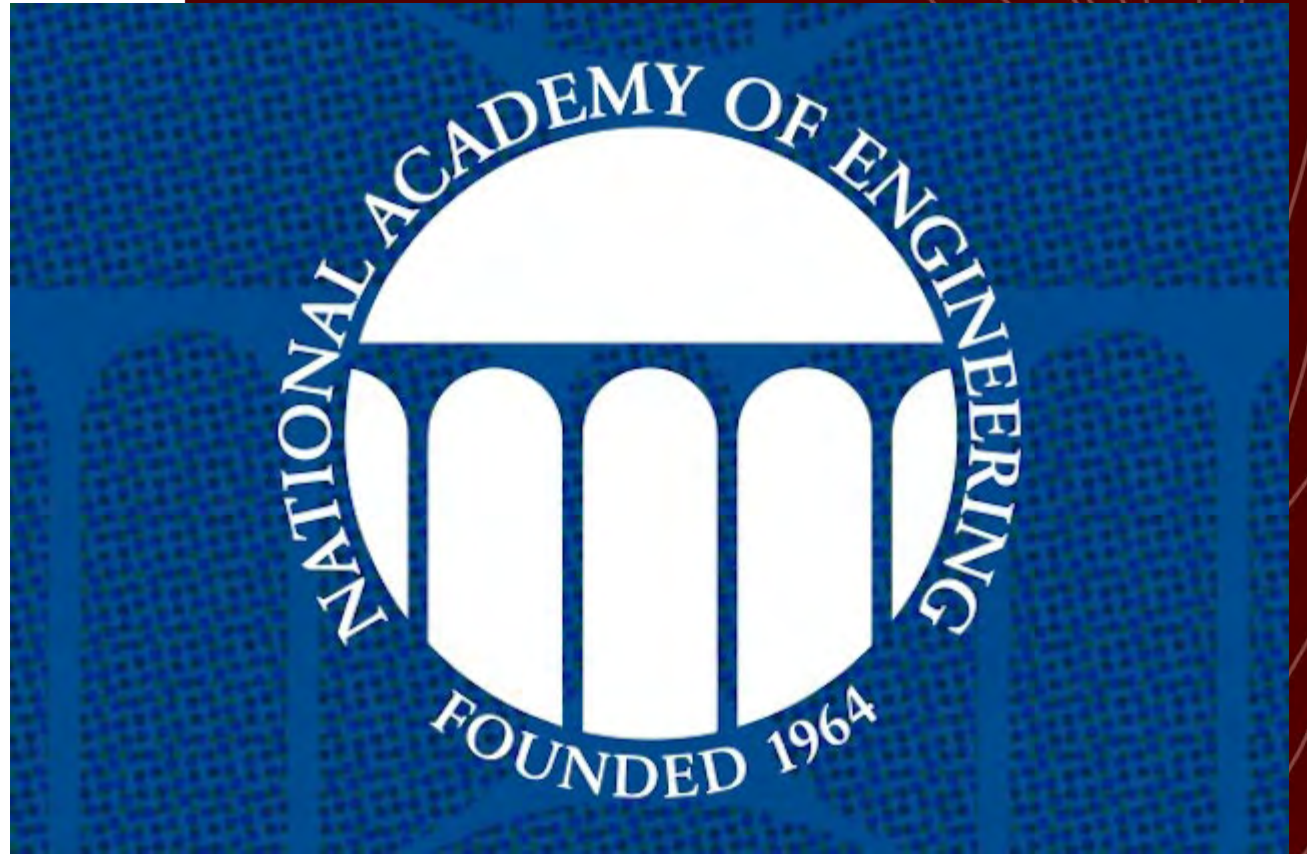
