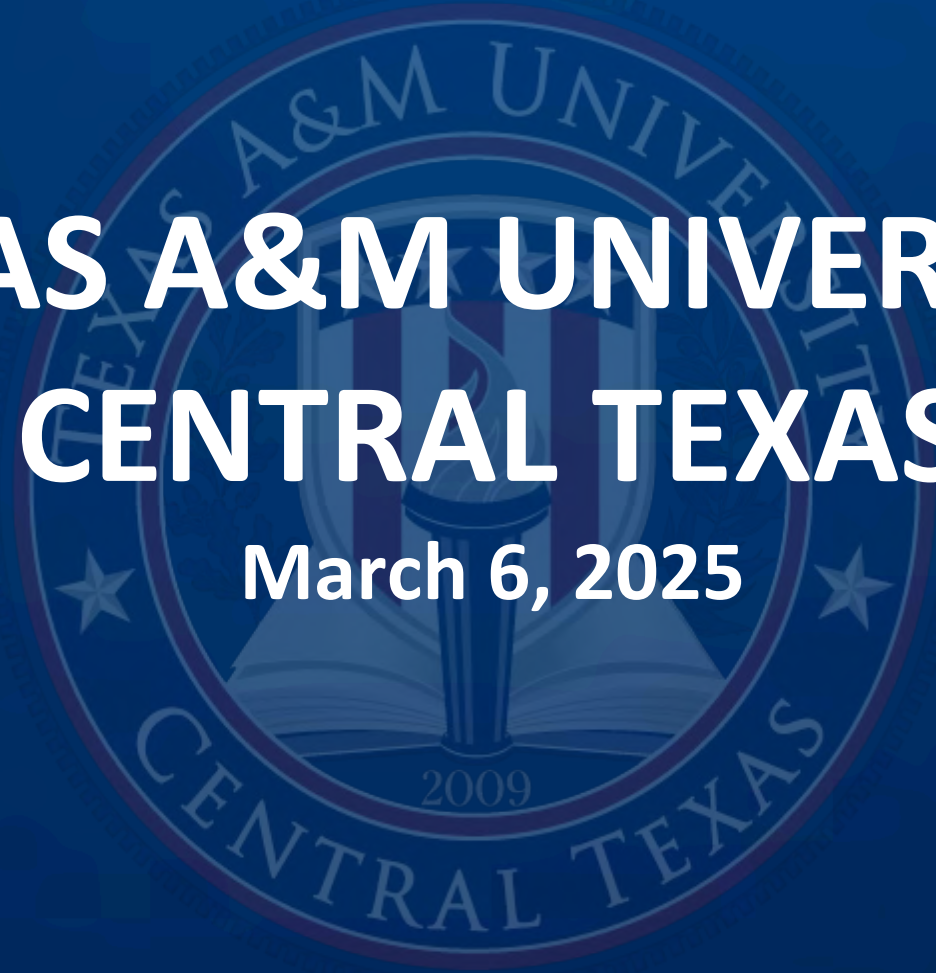




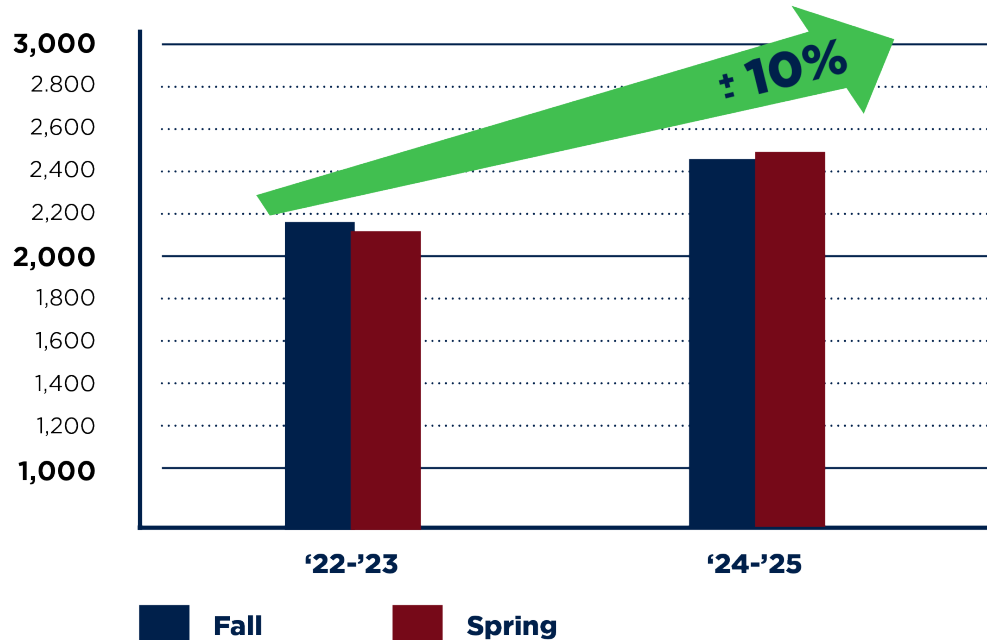

# A&M–Central Texas Enrollment Trends

- Up approximately 10% since 2022-23
- SCH enrollment is up 21% over the previous base year
- Graduate student enrollment is up approximately 33% in that time period
- Graduate students make up approximately 28% of our current enrollment



# Degrees Conferred

- As of December 2024, A&M–Central Texas has awarded 11,311 degrees
- 57% of our graduates were the first in their family to receive a university degree



# Student Statistics

- 71.5% of our students are part-time
- Our students live and work in 175 of the 254 counties in Texas
- Our students are in all 50 states, the territory of Puerto Rico, and 18 countries throughout the world

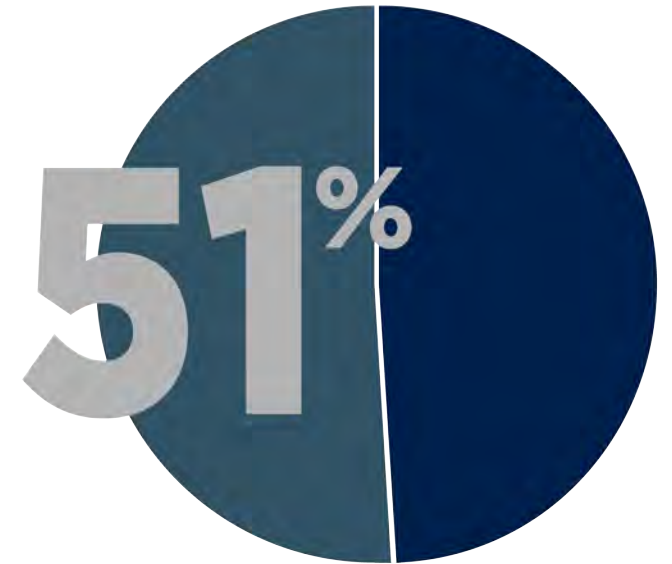

# ROTC

- Large contingent of Green to Gold students means many of our ROTC students have enlisted experience, benefitting the younger cadets
- Graduated 78 commissioned officers since 2022, with another 21 to be commissioned in May
- Approximately 12% of our ROTC graduating officers score in the top 10% of ROTC grads nationally

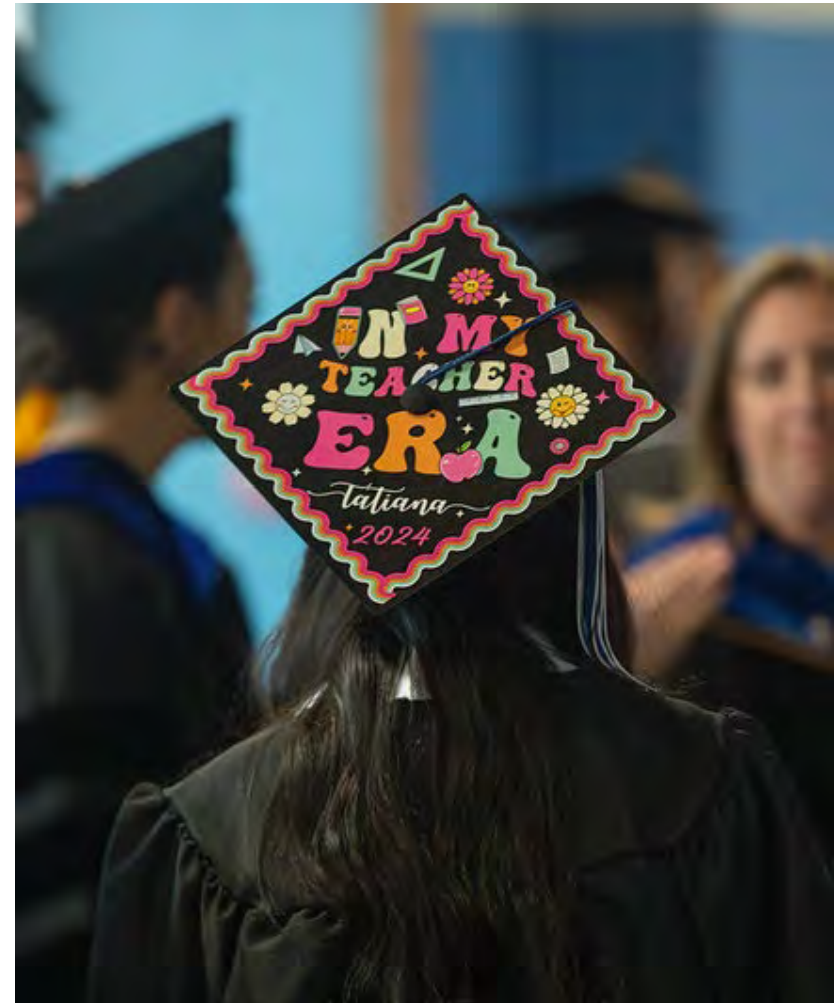

# Affordability

- In August 2024, Money Talk News names A&M–Central Texas the #1 Least Expensive/Most Affordable university in the U.S.
- 68% of undergraduate students receive some form of financial assistance
- 56% of graduate students receive some form of financial assistance
- 65% of students receive Pell Grants
